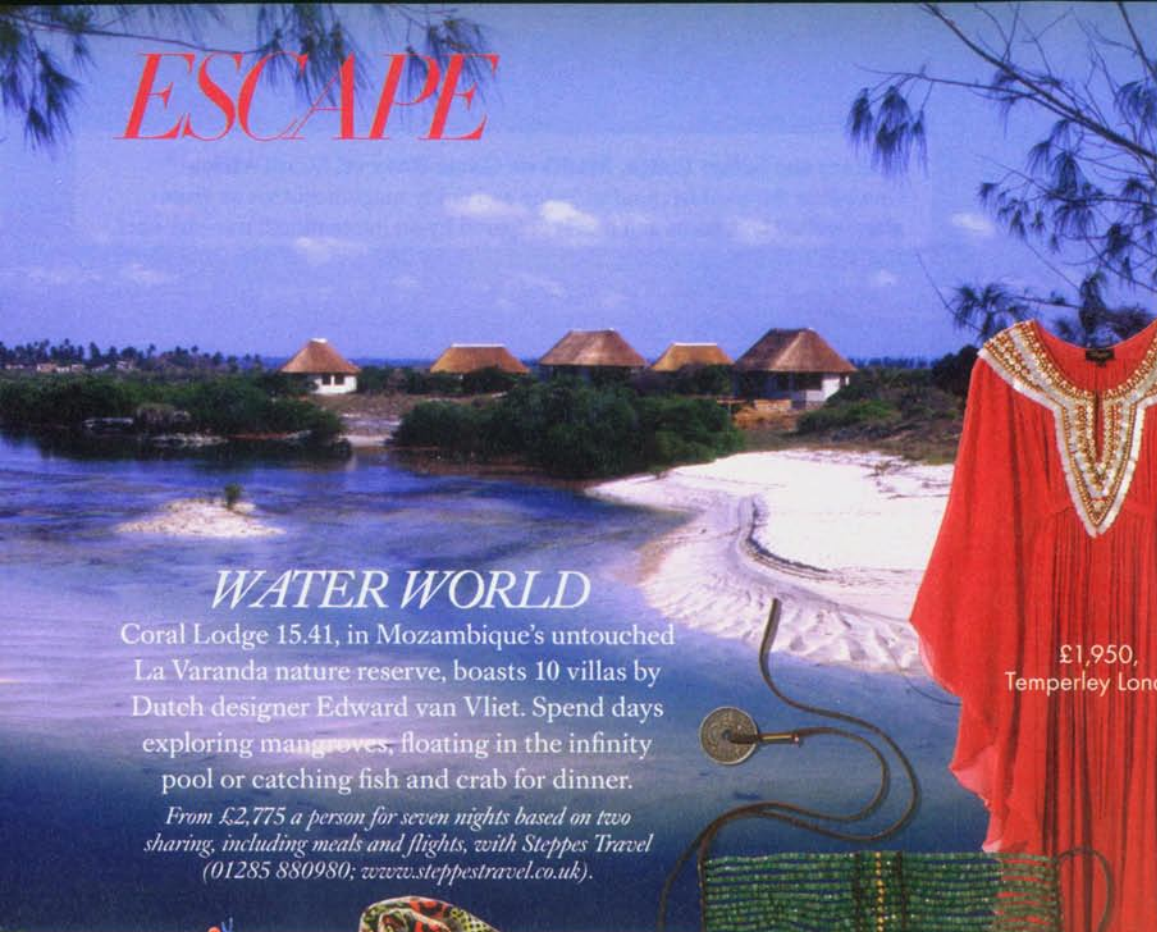

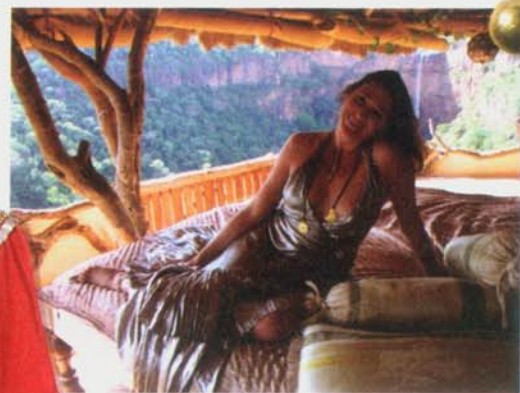




WATER WORLD

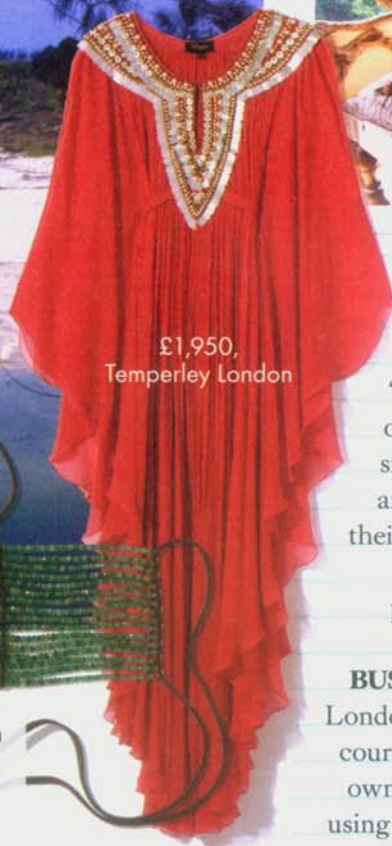
Jeweller Carolyn Roumequère gives her top travel tips

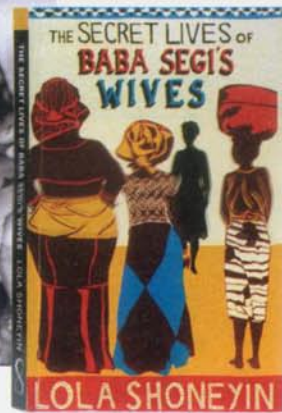
